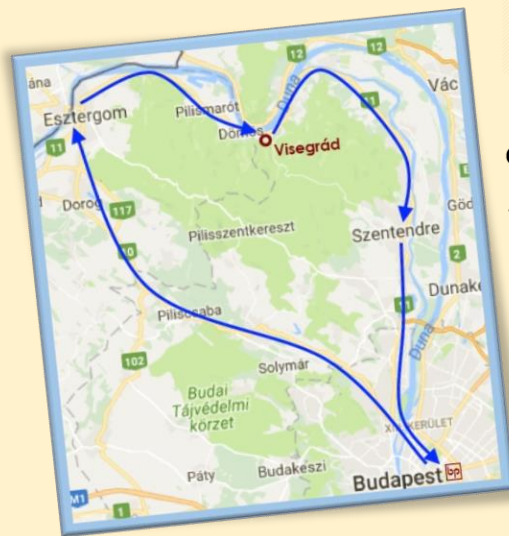


DANUBE BEND TOUR

Departure from the venue's main entrance on the 3rd of July at 08:00.
(Dózsa György út 1 – please look for the hostess)



The bus drives to Esztergom, Visegrád and Szentendre,
three scenic towns before heading back to the capital.

Esztergom: It used to be the capital of Hungary and is still the centre of the Catholic Church. We visit the largest cathedral of Hungary (also burial place of famous cardinals, like Primate József Mindszenty). Afterwards, we drive across the river to Slovakia and enjoy the view over the Basilica.

Visegrád: After the Mongol invasion a new fortification was constructed here in the mid-13th century. The top of the hill offers a fascinating panorama on the Danube valley. After enjoying the view, we provide you lunch at the wonderful Sirály Restaurant. (see below)

Szentendre: It is a small baroque city built on medieval ruins, located at the gate of the Danube Bend. The town is considered to be the Artists' Village or the Painters' Town. We walk around the historical centre and enjoy the cobblestoned narrow streets as well as the baroque houses. After the guided tour you can also visit some museums (for example the famous Margit Kovács Ceramic Museum or the Confectionery Museum with marzipan figures).



After the walk along in Visegrád streets, we provide you **lunch**
at the wonderful **Sirály Restaurant**.



At the end of the day, **you'll set sail on a cruise boat back to Budapest**.
You'll disembark at one of the city's piers near the Chain Bridge.
